



UNIPOWER BATTERY RECYCLING PROGRAM

1. Separate batteries by type (lead-acid, NiCad, alkaline, etc).
2. Pack in boxes by type. Limit weight per box to 35 – 40 pounds each.
3. Make sure the battery terminals are protected from shorting.
4. Call Unipower to obtain an RGA (return goods authorization) number.
5. Ship the best way (pre-paid) to:

Lead acid batteries may be disposed of locally at any salvage facility that handles automotive batteries. This would save the expense of shipping lead acid batteries to Minneapolis.
